LIFETIME GIFTING AND GIFTING FROM YOUR ESTATE: You may make a gift to American Spaniel Club, Inc. of your dog memorabilia; for example, collectibles, videotapes, show catalogues, photographs, artwork or other property, items which your family or heirs are not interested in having, but which would be greatly appreciated by the fancy at ASC. By creating a Will or having your attorney make a simple revision (codicil) to your Will, you can choose one of several ways to benefit this organization which you have enjoyed supporting. If, like many others, you have chosen a Revocable Trust to pass your property on to loved ones, consider how you might add a gifting dimension to this plan as well.

INFORMATION ON BEQUESTS:

OUTRIGHT: An outright bequest is for specified items of personal property.

RESTRICTED AND UNRESTRICTED BEQUEST WORDING

UNRESTRICTED

RESTRICTED

I give, devise, and bequeath to the American Spaniel Club, Inc., a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, Federal Tax ID #11-6003398, certain items of personal property described as follows: _____ to be used for (specific purpose). The more limited the designation of the bequest, the more important it is to add a provision such as the following:

In the event that such use should prove to be impracticable or undesirable for any reason the organization shall determine, it shall then provide for alternative uses of the gift in a manner consistent with, and reflecting the spirit of the original gift.
